EVENTS: Men's and women's 3m springboard and 10m platform
Men's and women's 3m synchro and 10m synchro

Event Format:

3M and Platform events – there will be a preliminary, a semi-final and a final. The top 12 divers in the preliminary will advance to the semi-final. The top 8 divers in the semi-final will advance to the final. For each segment of the competition, the divers score will start at “0” points.

3M and Platform Synchro events – will be a straight final.

EQUIPMENT LIST

- (2) one metre Maxiflex "C" boards
- (2) three metre Maxiflex "C" boards
- Freestanding concrete tower including 3m, 5m, 7.5m.and 10m.
- Full bubbler system is located under the platforms.

RULES

The 2009-2010 FINA and Diving Plongeon Canada Rules shall be the official rules for this event. If there are any inconsistencies between this package and the Rule Book, the Rule Book shall prevail. Any decisions made at this championship by the Jury of Appeal shall be final. The Rule book is also available at www.diving.ca

For the 3m and 10 trials events, cuts will be to 12 for semi-finals and to 8 for the finals (as noted above).

For club points, senior qualification scores and junior qualification scores, diver scores and rankings used will be based on 1st to 8th place in the finals and 9th to 12th place in the semi-finals. Rule H.1. in Chapter R-2 of the Hand Book and Rule book will apply to any non-Canadian divers in the events, however with cuts to 12 and 8 respectively for semi-finals and finals.

JUDGING

Refer to 2009-2010 Diving Plongeon Canada Rule Book. Dress code is in effect. All judges will be required to wear white shirts and black bottoms. For finals black pants is mandatory.

COACH CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

To attend a Diving National Championship, coaches must be fully certified Level 2 in the old system or at the Competition-Introduction Level. Coaches not having full certification may attend provided they are with a coach from their club who is fully certified at Level 2 or Competition-Introduction or at a higher level

ENTRY FEES AND ENTRY DEADLINE

We ask that you enter and submit your lists for individual and synchro events for the Winter Senior Nationals using the Dive Sheet Generator. www.rezman.net

If you are unable to submit your lists over the internet, you will be able to fill in your dive sheets when you arrive. Dive sheets can be submitted at the same time as your entries.

For all dive sheets received through the Dive Sheet Generator, you will receive e-mail notification confirming receipt. Should you not receive this confirmation, please contact us.

All fees are payable to the Canadian Amateur Diving Association Inc. Payment can be made by VISA, Mastercard, cheque or money order. If paying by credit card, an administrative fee of 3% will be added to the total.

Diving Canada will verify the results on the database. The club will be contacted if results sheets are required.

RESULTS

Participating club and unattached diver/coach will be able to download the full results booklet from www.diving.ca the week following the event.

Diving Plongeon Canada will be providing live internet results and video throughout the competition. Results can be accessed through www.diving.ca or through www.rezman.net.

Live internet video will be broadcasted for the entire event. Please promote this feature to family and friends of athletes.

DOPING

Doping tests will be conducted at the Winter National Championships.

A Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) application is required to be submitted by divers who need to take a substance that is banned. Exemptions are granted by CCES.

Within Canada, TUEs are not required for glucocorticosteroids or beta-2 agonists, but must be declared at the time a doping test is undertaken, and TUEs submitted retroactively. A complete medical review will be required.

NOTE: Registered Testing Pool athletes MUST have TUEs submitted at least 21 days in advance –to FINA. RTP athletes cannot apply TUEs retroactively.

AS WELL: Divers who are selected for international competitions, including Canada Cup, must obtain exemptions from FINA (with a copy to CCES) a minimum of 21 days prior to the application international competition. TUEs cannot be applied retroactively for international competitions.
